The new seven-story, 600,000 square-foot hospital will have 164-beds with the same services currently provided at Western Memorial Regional Hospital, as well as an expanded cancer care program, including radiation services. The new hospital will connect to the newly constructed 145-bed Corner Brook Long-term Care Facility on the same site.

The Government of Newfoundland and Labrador and Western Regional Health Authority reached financial close on the project on August 9, 2019.
